Description	In this project GreenHouse-Workcamps developed to teach how to plan and implement ecological building projects. A workcamp consists of at least eight theory and practice modules from different disciplines (structural engineering, finishing crafts, electric, solar) which can be combined. The results are finished buildings that can remain in use by schools or associations. The "GreenHouse-Workcamp" is carried out twice a year at the localities of the three participating partners for at least three days for each camp. At every workcamp 20 young adults under the age of 25, looking for occupational orientation, were able to participate. During the three year period 360 participants explored the aspects of constructing sustainably and discover the work areas of the construction crafts. The participants were evaluated and in some cases recommended for a trainee or apprenticeship to construction companies.
